

My name is **Marissa Lesley**. I am 43 years old from Dexter, Missouri. I have been on and off drugs since I was 12 years old. I never really felt like I fit in anywhere and I've always struggled with low self-esteem issues. I came from a good family. My parents divorced when I was young, but they were both good and loving parents. Neither one of my parents ever had addiction problems. I started hanging out with the wrong crowd in school and that was my first step towards my downfall. By the age of 16, I was introduced to meth and by the age of 17- I was using meth through a needle. The needle has been a demon in my life for a very long time. I have been In and out of prison three times, went

to thirteen rehabs over the years, and I have no idea how many outpatient drug classes I've been to. I've had years before where I could remain clean and free to drugs, but as soon as pressures came, I ran back to the only thing I knew of to "help me get through". I always ran back to drugs when things get too stressful or something traumatic happened. I'm tired of running to that temporary high and that false security. I am no longer a runner-I am a child of God!! I've been here at Freedom House learning to TRUST JESUS in all things big and small. It's not about reading the Bible here and there and just feeling better for a moment. It's about having a relationship with Jesus. *"Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be added unto you."* Matthew 6:33. Since I've been here my mom has been healed of rectal cancer, my oldest daughter, Aylah has given birth to my first grandson and He is restoring my relationship with my two younger children. I serve a big God and He is a God of restoration. I thank Him every day for saving me out of my mess and leading me here to Freedom House. It has changed my life in so many ways that it's hard to even try to put it in words. He knew exactly what I needed and when I needed it. *"For my thoughts are not your thoughts nor are my ways your ways says the Lord for as the Heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts."* Isaiah 55:8,9
