A couple of years prior I was laid off from work and faced with a breakup, repossession, and foreclosure which left me homeless and once again addicted. I was at a point in my life where I needed help and quick. I have 4 children, and I was always involved in their lives; it is strange how things can change overnight. In the last few years, I have overdosed 3 times on fentanyl, and that was not even the drug I was doing. After the EMT's brought me back the last time I wasn't the same. I had lost my main motor skills and the thoughts running through my mind were crazy, I thought I did too much, I'll never be the same. I was wrong, the Lord had his hand on me the entire time. ***"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*** **Jeremiah 29:11.** The Lord sent a messenger to pick me up and bring me to safety. I may have had to lose everything to get here, but some things must fall apart before they can be put back together. I have been at Freedom House for over 5 months now, not all days have been easy, but they are much better than they have ever been in my life. The Lord has restored the joy and peace in my heart, and I am finally grateful for all that He has done for me. Now I understand the reason it is called Freedom House; Jesus has set me FREE! I cannot think of anything else I'd rather be doing. What a blessing, even if I didn't see it in the beginning. I am home with my family now.
