My name is **Michael Luttrell**. I am a child of God...31 years old from Kennett, Missouri. My father was very abusive, so my mother took us and got away from him. This left me feeling angry and rejected. When I was 10 years old, my family owned a liquor store. I watched everyone drink and thought it looked like fun. I took my first drink at 13 years old, and I was instantly hooked. I watched my family do drugs and again, wanted to try to fit it. It started with marijuana and ended with meth, guns, gangs and eventually jail. My grandmother passed away while I was in jail, and they released me to go to the funeral, but I never made it. I went right back to the streets and my old behavior. It felt different this time because I knew I needed help. I was searching for Jesus. I lost my family and everything else due to my addictions and decisions. I went to a halfway house and ended up right back where I was. I needed more. Eventually I came to Freedom House. When I got here, I felt a peace and I knew that the Lord wanted me right here. Ten days after I got here, we found out I had a warrant. I was tempted to run again, but this time I heard the voice of the Lord asking me if I really wanted to destroy my life even more. I decided to turn myself in and do my time and come back. I was in jail for 2 months and then returned to Freedom House just like I said I would. Since I have been here, Jesus has helped me with my anxiety and He has taken my anger and replaced it with joy. I feel alive in Him, and I finally have a life worth living. My mother was put in the hospital for a long time for some breathing issues, but Jesus used this to build my faith as I was able to witness Him heal her. This is a process. You have to remember that your life did not become a mess overnight...let the Lord, Jesus Christ restore you. **"Can anyone of you by worrying add a single hour to your life.?" Matthew 6:27**
