My name is **Patrick Cook**. I am 40 years old and from St. Louis, Missouri. I was raised by parents who did well but were alcoholics. Growing up, I always felt different and had very few friends. I also had a hard time fitting in anywhere because I was a very sick kid and couldn't participate in what "normal kids" do which led to me feeling left out and very alone. Growing up, I always said that I would never smoke, drink or do drugs and I didn't until I went to college. That's where my addiction to alcohol started and eventually led me to losing my job, home and everything I owned

and cost me all of my friends and loved ones. Throughout all of this., I struggled with depression, anxiety, guilt, shame, fear, rejection and condemnation from myself and other people. I had heard of Jesus since my childhood but never really had a personal relationship with Him. Well, a few months before I turned 40, I had finally had enough of the life I had been living and just called on Jesus.
